Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Minimum one year college at an accredited institution; G.P.A. 2.5/4.0, majoring in biology, education, early childhood development, or other relevant field.• Minimum 18 years of age.• Completion of a reflective journal or project required as part of internship.• Strong interpersonal communications and organizational skills.• Strong computer skills.• Must be able to commit to 12 weeks; approximately 40 hours/week.
