- Show kindness to animals by not touching or chasing them.
- Protect animals by not throwing food or objects into their homes.
- Leave plants in place so they can grow and stay beautiful.

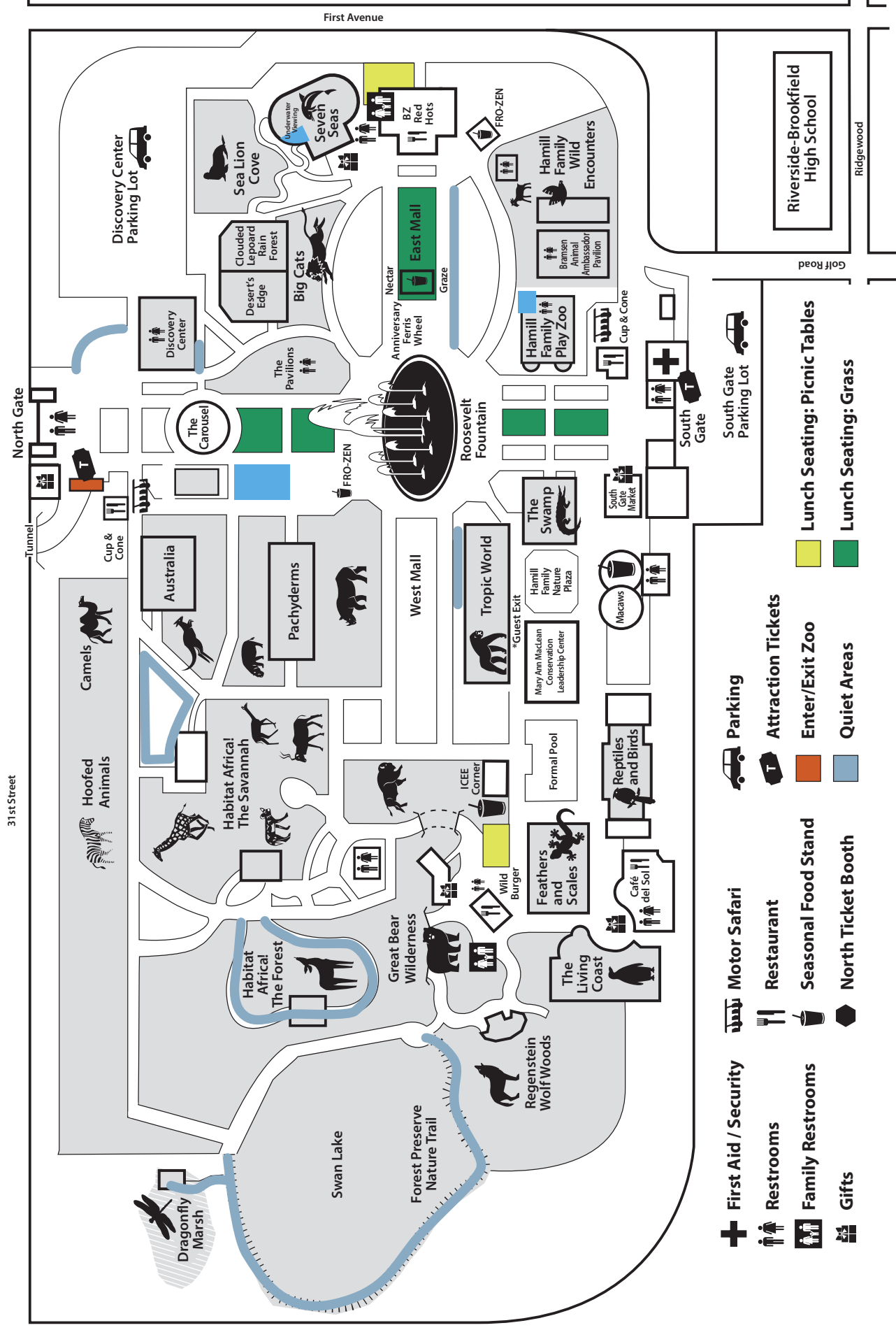


ENJOY AND HELP US.
